- You will be expected to prepare and deliver a *3 to 5 minute* speech about the Brussels Fair.

## Impromptu:

- You will be expected to answer an impromptu question related to your fair.

## FAIR QUEENS & KINGS EXPECTATIONS

If you win the competition, as ambassador, it is expected that you will help with activities prior to the fair but related to the fair. **This**

**includes...**

- Fair Crafts day at the Library
- Visiting local schools to promote the fair and a hand out prize ribbons at various competitions and shows through the fair
- Be at the fair fully on both fair-days as well as in the fair parade on the float
- Participate in community Santa Claus parades, both in and outside of Brussels
- Attend Brussels Agricultural Society Meetings
- Speak to and engage in community organizations, groups, clubs, and events

**Part of being the ambassador also includes...**

- Attending the Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies (OAAS) Convention for 3 days in Toronto in February and is suggested to compete in the Canadian National Exhibition (CNE) Ambassador of the Fairs Competition in Toronto in August.
- Suggested to compete for the district ambassador.
